The Leadership Team is a leadership development program within camp. All applicants will be notified of selections by **May 25th**, pending background checks. The cost to attend camp for the Leadership Team is \$175.

All young adults selected to be on this year's team are required to attend a day-long training held at St. Luke's Episcopal Church in Minneapolis on June 17th. As well as receiving needed training, we will have some time for community building, and receive schedules, camper lists, and divide up other responsibilities. All LT members will also be asked to come to camp on **August 5th** for some training/team building before the campers arrive on August 6th.

All Camp Staff Training will take place on **Saturday, June 17th** at St. Luke's Episcopal Church in Minneapolis, MN. SafeGuarding God's Children will be from 9am – Noon and the all staff training will be 1pm – 4:30pm. It is our goal to have everyone in attendance to receive assignments, camper lists, mentoring details and to go over the schedule. If for some reason you cannot attend, please connect with Katrina Gadwa to schedule a separate training time.

Staff arrival at camp is Saturday, August 5th. Our staff meeting will begin at 7pm sharp. The camp director will notify us a week prior to camp as to what time we can begin moving in. In past years, we could move in around 6pm. Our goal is to have all of our staff ready to go by 7pm. If you will be coming with a camper or tag-a-long it is suggested that arrangements are made so they can arrive when the other campers arrive if possible. Carpooling with other campers and/or utilizing relatives to bring them to camp is a suggestion.
