**Staff arrival** at camp is Saturday, August 5<sup>th</sup>. Our staff meeting will begin at 7pm sharp. The camp director will notify us a week prior to camp as to what time we can begin moving in. If you will be coming with a camper or tag-a-long it is suggested that arrangements are made so they can arrive when the other campers arrive if possible.
